




Global growth on recovery path

India's Economic Outlook robust, some risks remain...

Growth Drivers

- Strengthening of macroeconomic fundamentals through structural reforms in the recent past.
- Normal monsoons (predicted) to revive agricultural growth.
- Revival in investment activity: Improvement in production of capital goods, expansion of manufacturing PMI.
- Improving global growth outlook may enhance export demand

Risk Factors

- Quality of public finances might have an adverse impact on private investment.
- Investment rate remains below 30%
- Continuing over-leveraged position in some of the sectors may inhibit performance of the overall economy.
- Increase in crude oil prices could constrain domestic consumption and remains a risk.
- Rising international protectionism

Ensure efficient pricing and allocation of resources such as minerals, spectrum, and water

6. Leveraging North Eastern Region

- Capacity building for youth (about 1900 youth trained) and in entrepreneurship.
- Actively promoting Bamboo production and marketing and food processing thus creating market linkages.

CII proposes to

- Promotes investment in NorthEast.
- Proposes to set up second Multi Skill Centers in collaboration with different State Governments in the region.
- Proposes one Model Skill Centre to be set up
- Promoting North East through CII Myanmar Office to reach ASEAN



7. Promoting Backward Districts

- CII runs several projects at the district level in diverse domains.
 - CII in partnership with Pan-IIT Alumni Reach for India have set up 22 Skill Gurukuls in the backward districts.
 - The CII Multi Skill Institute in Madhya Pradesh is training in 9 trades and benefiting over 3000 youth per annum
- ➤ Proposes to come out with District Development plans and identify short term and long term interventions in 35 districts across 18 states
- ➤ Promote dietary diversity in 25 high priority districts awareness generation and consumer campaigns around diets rich in high quality protein, fibre and micronutrients.
