Vedic Farm & the Ritual of Agnihotra

Sylvan Heights Bio- dynamic & Vedic Farm is situated at Batamandi in Uttarakhand. Mr Subodh Abbhi who owns the farm says that the ancient vedic ritual of Agnihotra is performed twice a day at his farm. Agnihotra, as prescribed in the Vedas is performed at sunrise and sunset, for purifying the environment, marshalling the cosmic forces for plant and soil vitality and to keep the environment and plants pure. A copper pyramid is used to light a fire which works as a receiver and transmitter of subtle healing energies. The Agnihotra effect covers an area of 15 acre and it gives nutrition to all of life plants, animals and humans.

The farm uses a set of eight herbal and mineral preparations to enliven the soil and the surrounding environment. The farm also uses various wild growing plants like lantenna, bhang, congress grass etc for making liquid manures. Cow urine is used as a spray to combat pests, and as a plant nutrient.

This 25 acre farm is certified by INDOCERT, an APEDA approved certifying agency for organic food products. The product range includes Kasturi Brown Basmati Rice, Organic Turmeric, Organic Maize Flour, Organic Groundnut, and Spices & Pulses.

Future of Indian Agriculture- Sustaining Indian Agriculture Growth

Mr Mohammad Asif Rahimi, Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture, Irrigation & Livestock, Afghanistan invited Indian farmers and industry to invest in Afghanistan. He said that Afghanistan offers Indian entrepreneurs great opportunity as they would be welcomed in his country with an open heart.

Mr Paramvir Singh, Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Cooperation and Fisheries Department, Government of Haryana, suggested Technology Mission in Farm Development. Mr Gokul Patnaik, Chairman of Agro Tech conferences, spoke about the agriculture scenario. Gujarat was the only state in India which had recorded 9.6 percent growth in Agriculture, while the national average was only 2.3 percent. There is a need for a second green r



average was only 2.3 percent. There is a need for a second green revolution. Soil health, hybrid seeds and minimum support price need to be looked into.

Mr S Venkatraman, Senior Director and Head of Food and Agribusiness Research and Advisory, Rabo India Finance Ltd. emphasized the need for focusing on various aspects of agriculture like seed replacement, fertilizers and improvement of soil testing facilities in order to rejuvenate it.




UK Pavilion – Interest from dairy sector

In Alwar, Waterman, Rajendra Singh started the initiative of community driven de- centralized water management focusing on increasing the greenery and conserving rain water through rain water harvesting.
