Global Outreach

CII undertakes research and analysis on areas related to the ongoing negotiations at the World Trade Organization (WTO), bilateral and regional Free Trade Agreement (FTA) negotiations, foreign trade policy and other related issues. CII – IL plays a key role in facilitating world class trade by making India most efficient and effective in logistics, thereby moving up the logistics performance index ladder.

- Education Services: In a step towards increasing availability of qualified logistics and supply chain professionals and educators, two key education programmes are implemented. Industry recognized qualification programmes (certificate, advanced certificate) are offered for working professionals in online. domestic production and improving overall as well as export competitiveness. The first edition of the index was released by Shri Piyush Goyal, Minister of Commerce and Industry and Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution and Textiles, Government of India.

Surveys: We conduct surveys to capture trends for informed decision making. CII has rich experience conducting large in-depth firm level surveys investigating wide ranging areas such as business outlook, investment implementation, sector surveys and several other issue-based surveys. The service includes designing the questionnaire, administering, and analysing the same. The survey-based research conducted by the specialized survey research team, serves as both policy inputs for the Government and regulators besides helping shape up future policy.

CII Quarterly Business Outlook Survey - to capture the prevailing business sentiments in the country. The survey results are quoted by RBI and referred by economy watchers and CII's own membership.

Occasional White Papers on Economy - CII Research team works on various white papers on the economy. Last year, since CII was the secretariat for B20 (Business 20), under the G20 umbrella, CII Research came out with a white paper on 'Global Economic Recovery: Towards Overall Global Prosperity'.

India State Reports - To further strengthen its state level policy work, CII is working on State Reports providing comprehensive analysis of the state economies. The reports, prepared basis secondary research and extensive industry consultations, make suggestions for growth and economic development of the State economies, outlining specific interventions- vertical and horizontal in these states.



Technology Services

As India marches ahead towards its vision of Viksit Bharat@2047, CII is also strategizing for a new orbit in shaping technology for this growth trajectory. The primary focus is to bring technology to centre stage and make it as a movement in the Indian Industry to enhance technology competitiveness. CII Technology Division is equipped with highly experienced professionals & networked with a large number of professional institutions and experts in the country and overseas. The Division works in tandem with Indian industry to develop & promote innovative technologies and to establish the right linkages for successful technology absorption and commercialisation. The CII Technology services are offered through industry and institutional partnerships, various forums, academia, startup, and research ecosystem.

Intellectual Property Facilitation Service

With the vision to transform India into an IP intensive nation, CII Centre for Intellectual Property helps to protect, monetize and enforce IP and caters to more than 2000 IPR services.

The Centre has so far facilitated filing of more than 600 patents(India and Abroad), 1700TMs, 2000 Designs, 300 copyrights and 50 GI's. Through capacity building, the Centre has supported more than 6000 stakeholders through 300 IP programs.

The Centre has dedicated team of in-house IP experts. It provides single window quality service on all types of IP services in a cost-effective manner. The Centre offers following services:

- Counselling on IPR to various stakeholders.
- Searching, drafting/preparing, filing and processing of applications in the areas of patent, design, trademark and copyright.
- Documentation, study & survey, filing and registration and post interventions for geographical indication.
- IP portfolio management, IP audit and IP commercialization.

Skill Development

Over last four decades, CII has been working with Industry towards building a robust skill development ecosystem in India, through policy advocacy and on-ground initiatives, forming a bridge between Industry and the youth. The focus of CII Skills has been on increasing Industry competitiveness and creating social impact, thus creating a workforce empowered with Industry Ready skills, knowledge and internationally recognized qualifications to gain access to decent employment and ensure India's competitiveness in the dynamic global market.
