CII PRIVACY POLICY

Confederation of Indian Industry (also referred as "CII/We") is committed to being a responsible custodian of the information you provide to us and the information we collect in the course of operating our business. This Privacy Policy describes how CII may collect, use, and share information, particularly in association with the operation of our websites, mobile applications, web applications and HTML-formatted emails that link to this Privacy Policy (collectively, "Online Services").

CII takes your privacy very seriously and ask that you read this privacy policy (the "Policy") carefully as it contains important information about what to expect when CII collects personal information about you and how the CII will use your personal data.

The types of information we collect

- A) Personal data: We collect your personal information when you provide it to us. "Personal information" is any information that can be used to identify you or that we can link to you as an individual. We may automatically collect certain information when you use, access, or interact with our Online Services.
- To use our Online Services (example product Apps), you must provide an email and username, and you will set a password. If you did not submit this information yourself, we have received this information from the Licensee (event organiser, recruiter, or any Licensor of our product/ Online Services across any industry) to invite you to use the Apps and to pre-populate certain fields in the Apps. An App Provider may request additional information about you beyond a user name and email address. It is up to you how much additional personal information you share with us, the Licensor, and the other users of the Online Services (example App).
- We may also collect information from other sources, such as social media platforms when you have linked your social media profiles to our Online Services. When using the Online Services, you may choose to create social profiles that display your name, job title, company, links to your social profiles (Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn) and activity. In addition to the above, you may contribute through chats, posts, responses/ answers, comments, surveys, messages, poll responses, photos, videos and any other App-related functions or features that may be available to you. Please do not include personal information in your chats, posts, responses/ answers, photos, videos, comments, likes, surveys, messages, or poll responses. If you are an event organizer, you may also provide us with conference agendas, customer lists, exhibitor lists, and

other information. We suggest you exercise caution while sharing your personal information and your views and opinions.

- B) Personal data we collect through your use of our Online Services We collect limited personal data from you which you chose to provide to us and beyond this data, we collect IP address, browser software, operating system, UUID/ device ID and location info and the time and date on which you visited the Online Services. In addition, we may also track your usage of the Apps for statistical and research purposes by means of cookies or usage pattern.
- C) Analytics information: We use third-party analytics tools to help us measure traffic and usage trends for the Online Services. These tools collect information sent by your device or our Online Services including the time you spent per visit, the features used and other information that assists us in improving the Online Services.
- D) Log Files Information: When you use our Online Services, our servers automatically record certain log file information, including your download request, the time spent on the usage, the features used and other such information. The information allows us to understand the usage better and identify areas of improvement.

2. How we use the information we collect: We may use your information we collect:

- To respond to your enquiries:
- To send you newsletters and other updates on the services we provide, marketing
 communications, and other information or materials that may be of interest you or
 which you have expressed an interest in receiving;
- To maintain our list of contacts;
- To assess the effectiveness of our events, promotional campaigns and publications;
- Help you efficiently access your information;
- Provide personalised content and information to you and others which could include online ads or other forms of marketing;
- Monitor metrics such as total number of visitors, traffic, and demographic patterns
- Diagnose or fix technology problems; and
- As we believe reasonably necessary or appropriate to: comply with our legal obligations; respond to legal process or requests for information issued by government authorities or other third parties; or protect your, our, or others' rights;

3. How we share the information we collect: We may also disclose information we collect:

- To third-party service providers that perform services on our behalf, such as webhosting companies, mailing vendors, analytics providers, event hosting services and information technology providers.
- To law enforcement, other government authorities, or third parties (within or outside the jurisdiction in which you reside) as may be permitted or required by the laws of any jurisdiction that may apply to us; as provided for under contract; or as we deem reasonably necessary to provide our services. In these circumstances, we take reasonable efforts to notify you before we disclose information that may reasonably identify you or your organisation, unless prior notice is prohibited by applicable law or is not possible or reasonable in the circumstances.
